- implications for curriculum design,
- insights on innovative classroom practice.

Presentations will have a duration of 20 min. We welcome abstracts of no more than 250 words specifying the title of the presentation, author(s) (name, affiliation, e-mail address), research design (research focus, research question(s), goal(s), methodology, instruments), research results (if applicable), and a list of references (the list of references does not count towards the word limit). Please also include a short bio of no more than 70 words.
